WOMAN'S REALL. VIRGINIA HOT BREADS.

In Virginia the hot breads which twice, if not three times, each day grace the family board, are considered essential to the personal comfort and well-being of the body...

VIRGINIA WAFFLES. Boil two cupfuls of hominy very soft; add an equal amount of Indian meal, one tablespoonful of butter, three eggs, a little salt, and milk to make a thin batter...

JOHNNY CAKE. Sift one quart Indian meal in a pan; make a hole in the centre and pour a pint of warm water to which a little salt has been added...

SOUR MILK BISCUITS. To a pint and a half sour milk add two teaspoonfuls salt; stir in sifted flour till nearly stiff enough to roll; add two teaspoonfuls saleratus dissolved in a little hot water...

CREAM TARTAR BISCUIT. Rub thoroughly into one quart sifted flour a bit of butter, two teaspoonfuls cream tartar, and a little salt; add one teaspoonful of soda dissolved in a little milk...

POTATO ROLLS. Select fine potatoes; boil, peel, and run through a sieve. For each potato allow one pint sifted flour, one egg, one-half cupful sugar, one gill milk-warm water, a saltspoonful of salt, the yolk of an egg, and a bit of butter...

RUSK. To four cupfuls flour add one-half cupful butter, one cupful sugar, and two eggs; mix thoroughly, adding enough flour to mold easily; with the hands form into high, narrow shapes...

SALTY LUNN. Mix the last thing before retiring at night, one-half pint milk, two eggs, one ounce melted butter, one teaspoonful sugar, one scant teaspoonful salt, one egg, and one gill good yeast...

VIRGINIA BISCUITS. Mix two pints flour, one tablespoonful lard, one teaspoonful salt, and enough water to make a stiff dough; turn out on a biscuit board and beat thirty minutes with an axe kept for the purpose...

VIRGINIA MUFFINS. Mix into a soft dough one quart of flour, one egg, one tablespoonful butter, one teaspoonful salt, one-half pint sweet milk, and one gill yeast. Let rise several hours, pour into muffin-
