Paris, March 30—Dr. Von Mayer the German Charge D'Affaires in Paris to-night handed to Premier Millerand a declaration from the German Gorern, ment, concerning the terms of occu-pation of the neutral zone by German Terman 34 St. Paul St. Montreal.
