II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall and may be lawful to and for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or person administering the Government of this Province, for the time being, by and with the advice of the said Board of Health, to take such measures for preventing the introduction or spreading (if already introduced or generated) of infectious or contagious disorders, as from the information so obtained, or otherwise may appear to him necessary, and for preventing the communication or the spreading of such disorders, and for the cure of such person or persons as shall be afflicted therewith, for the effecting of which, the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or person administering the Government of this Prnvince, for the time being, is hereby empowered to pay or cause to be paid, such reasonable charge and expense, as the urgency of the case may render necessary from time to time, which charge and expense shall be provided for by the Legislature of the Province, as soon thereafter as required.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall be lawful for the Inspector of the Port or his Deputy, to examine vessels arriving suspected of having any infectious or contagious disease on board, and to give such immediate orders to the master or masters relating to their anchoring at a distance from the town, or from other ships or vessels, or to prevent persons from landing from on board them, or persons from on shore going on board the same, or for performing quarantine, as to the said Inspector of the Port or to his Deputy, shall, in his discretion, appear immediately necessary, by reason of any contagious or infectious disease or diseases, on board of such arriving vessel or vessels (and the ground upon which such quarantine shall be performed, is hereby declared to be at the embouchure, or mouth of the River Saint Charles, below Quebec, commonly called the Bason of Quebec, not nearer the quay at the place commonly called and known by the name of **Pointe a Carcie** than one mile; and all and every master or masters, commander
