IV. And be it further enacted, That so much of an Act made in the Forty-first Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for allowing, until the Fifteenth Day of October One thousand eight hundred and one, the Use of Salt, Duty free, in the preserving of Fish in Bulk or in Barrels; for protecting Persons engaged in such Fisheries from being impressed into His Majesty's Service; for discontinuing the Bounty payable on White Herrings exported. and for allowing a Bounty on Pilchards now cured, whether exported or sold for Home Consumption,* as relates to allowing the Use of Salt Duty free in the preserving of Fish in Bulk or in Barrels, and to discontinuing the Bounty payable on White Herrings exported, which was continued by an Act of the last Session of Parliament until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and three, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and four.

V. And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Thirty-eighth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the further Encouragement of the Trade and Manufactures of the Isle of Man, for improving the Revenue thereof; and for the more effectual Prevention of Smuggling to and from the said Island,* which was continued and amended by an Act made in the Forty-first Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, and further continued by an Act made in the last Session of Parliament, until the Fifth Day of *July* One thousand eight hundred and three, shall be, and the same is, hereby further continued until the Fifth Day of *July* One thousand eight hundred and four.

VI. And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Twenty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the more effectual Encouragement of the Manufactures of Flax and Cotton in Great Britain,* which was to continue in Force for Two Years, from the First Day of *January* One thousand seven hundred and eighty-four, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, and which said Act was by several subsequent Acts further continued until the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and three, shall be, and the same is, hereby further continued until the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and six, except so much thereof as relates to allowing a Drawback of the Duties of Customs on the Importation of Brimstone used and consumed in making Oil of Vitriol.

And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for importing Salt from Europe into the Province of Quebec in America. for a limited Time,* which was to continue in Force from the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand seven hundred and sixty-four, for the Term of One Year, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, and which by several subsequent Acts was further continued until the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and two, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is, hereby further continued until the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and eight, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.
