UNB RESIDENCES

In about six week's time this term will end and, as always happens, some people will leave the residences and others will arrive to take their places. If YOU are one of those who will either be coming or going, please read on - it might even save you some money!

IF YOU ARE IN RESIDENCE NOW AND DO NOT PLAN TO RETURN IN JANUARY:

1. Tell your residence office NOW while you think of it. (Women's Residence Office: 453-4800; Men's Residence Office: 453-4835)

2. Whatever you do, be absolutely sure that you GIVE YOUR NOTICE BY DECEMBER 7 - the last day of classes.

3. If you fail to give notice by December 7 you will be subject to a surcharge of \$100.00, as set down in the current UNB Residence Fee Payment Schedule, para 2(F).

4. Bear in mind that the residences do not want your money; but they do want to know what beds will be available for the many students who have already applied for places in January - so do those students.

5. So help yourself by helping us and tell us your plans before December 7.

All residences (women's, men's and coed) have waiting lists for January and the number of vacancies will not be known until after December 7. However all new applicants will be accepted in chronological order until space is filled. If you are interested

and have NOT yet applied, please contact the appropriate office (see below) and complete an application form. If you have already applied, you will be notified of your reservation as soon as a suitable vacancy arises.
