Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your night lettergram of the 12th instant, which reads as follows,-
"Titan tractor ten twenty thirteen hundred thirty five dollars with plow and attachments about fifteen hundred dollars if procured at once will mean extra sixty acres grain crop three extra team horses or tractor necessary to provide sufficient power to properly operate farm one tractor available wire soon as convenient".

In reply I beg to confirm the following night lettergram, which was sent you today,- "Department will advance amount for tractor fifteen hundred dollars to be repaid in three annual instalments. First instalment of five hundred dollars will be deducted from the grant for the December quarter, next".
