Dear Sir:

Mr. McPherson of Avonhurst, Sask, has recently purchased the fractional quarter south of section 7, township 20, range 15, west 2nd M. and was in the office today enquiring the width of the parcel of land which he has purchased.

According to a blue print on file in this office, from a plan of Pasqua Reserve made by S. Bray in 1910, the S.W. corner of section 7 shows the width as 2.88, which is presumed is chains. The figures marked on the S.E. corner are not very distinct, but they might be 3.64. Would you advise me if this is correct.

Mr. McPherson is also anxious to know if there is a road allowance immediately south of the old boundary line of the Pasqua Reserve, and the northern boundary of the White settlement. Could you furnish this information please.
