the various band in the Northern part of Lake Winnipeg advising them of the dates appointed for the payments.

Mr. Senmens will be requested to notify the Bands on the southern part of the Lake.

You will see from the foregoing list that you will have to be in Selkirk not later than the 15th of June to serve the annuity money, which will be sent to you by the Bank of Montreal , Winnipeg care of the Dominion Bank Selkirk.

The Department is arranging for your transport to the various Reserves and you will be advised later when final arrangements are made.
