
Ottawa, May 21, 1909.

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th inst., inclosing a communication addressed to Mr. Indian Agent Lerens, embodying a resolution passed by the Advisory Board of the Port Simpson Girls' Home, in which that body asks that the pupilage at the institution be increased from thirty-five to forty-five and the per capita grant from \$60.00 to \$130.00.

In reply I beg to say that the Department has not funds available to grant either of these requests at present, but note has been made of the resolution for future consideration.
