Dear Mr. Miller,-

With reference to the letter of the 10th inst. from Rev. Geo. Carpenter, inclosed in your letter of the 15th inst., addressed to the Minister, I beg to say that Mr. Carpenter appears to be under quite a misapprehension in the matter of any proposed arrangement for the appointment of a provisional council for the Six Nations.

The Department has not yet given any orders with a view to the appointment of an elective council, and you may assure Mr. Carpenter that, if any provisional arrangement should be made, care will be taken not to allow any one religious denomination to have a much larger representation in such council than any other denomination.
