Sir:-

With reference to your letter of the 4th instant, relative to arrears of interest money paid Charlotte Sutherland by cheque No. 4346, I beg to say that the amount of the cheque (\$ 8.75) was made up as follows:-

Payment for the Spring of 1909.. ..	\$ 1.50
" " " Fall " "	1.20
" " " Spring " 1910	.80
" " " Fall " "	1.55
" " " Spring " 1913	1.20
" " " Fall " 1913	1.25
" " " Spring " 1914	1.25
	\$ 8.75

From the above statement you will observe that the payment for the Spring of 1910 should be eighty cents not \$ 1.55. The interest money for the Fall of 1911 and the Spring of that year was sent to you by cheque No. 1219. The cheque was sent on the 7th June, 1912, which fact you must have overlooked when making entries in the office copy of your pay-list.
