6. (a) Approval has been granted for:
- (i) Formation in UK of 47 Coy CWAC and the despatch, thereto, of 150 rfts.
  - (ii) The reorganization of CWAC to conform more closely to the organization of the ATS.

7. (a) Rehabilitation - Occupational History Forms - Insts have been issued for the completion of Occupational History Forms at an early date.
- (b) Can Army Personnel on loan to Security Services, RCMP - DOSC were advised of the names of all Army personnel selected for duty with the Security Services, RCMP. The mil status during their attachment was also outlined.
- (c) Agricultural leave - Harvest 1943 - Instrs were issued to Comds and Distts covering the granting of harvest leave up to six weeks, without Pay and Allowances, to soldiers who have had experience in farm work.
