

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE  
UNITED FARMERS OF QUEBEC**

**dated the thirty-first day of August 1918.**

**BETWEEN:—**

Lochaber Bay, in the Province of Quebec,  
Farmers.**

**ARTICLE 1.—The undersigned hereby  
unite for the following purposes:—**

**(a) To unite the members of the asso-  
ciation for mutual assistance in increasing  
the productivity of Canadian farms, in  
enhancing the value of farm property, and  
in improving the general conditions, econ-  
omic, and social of the farming community.**

**(b) To protect the interests of the farm-  
ing community by investigations of econ-  
omic conditions, prices, methods of trans-  
portation and distribution, by obtaining in-  
formation in any way relating to farm life  
for distributing among members, and by  
representing the economic and social con-  
ditions of the farming community to mun-**
