ARTICLE 1.—The undersigned hereby

(a) To unite the members of the association for mutual assistance in increasing the productivity of Canadian farms, in enchancing the value of farm property, and in improving the general conditions, economic, and social of the farming community.

(b) To protect the interests of the farming community by investigations of economic conditions, prices, methods of transportation and distribution, by obtaining information in any way relating to farm life for distributing among members, and by representing the economic and social conditions of the farming community to mun-
