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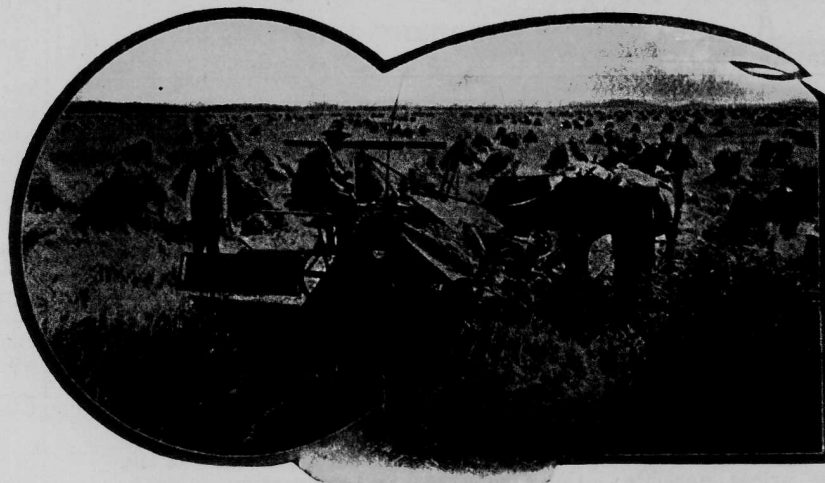
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The man who farms this place does not read agricultural papers. He doesn't believe in "book farmin'." The way his grandfather did is good enough for him.
