RE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act passed in the Third year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act to authorise the Sessions of the Peace for the County of Queen's County to make regulations for the gathering of Sea Manure in the said County, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for Three Years, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

## CAP. LXXXVIII.

An Act to continue the Acts to divide the Township of Maxweltown into separate Districts for the support of the Poor.

(Passed the 17th day of March, 1847.)

RE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act passed in the Eighth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act to divide the Township of Maxweltown into separate Districts for the support of the Poor, except as altered or amended by the Act hereinafter mentioned; and also, the Act passed in the Ninth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, to amend the said first mentioned Act, shall be continued, and the said Acts, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, except as before excepted, are hereby con-Anued for Two Years, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
