the body of any person deceased within or out of the same, in any place or Church yard situated within the walls of such City or Town, shall incur a penalty of—pounds.

- 4. That the fines incurred as above shall be fued for, levied and applied in the same manner as the fines imposed by the said Bill.
- 5. That the Preamble of the faid Bill be altered fo as to correspond with the aditional clauses resulting from the above resolutions.

A Message from the Legislative Council by the Honorable Mr. De Longueüil,

Mr. Speaker,

The Legislative Council have passed a Bill, intituled "An Act to alter" and amend the criminal Law in certain cases, and to provide more estimated the commission of crimes and offences,"—to which the Legislative Council desire the concurrence of this House.

And then he withdrew.

The House resumed the consideration of Mr. De Bonne's motion.

On motion of Mr. Grant, seconded by Mr. Lester,

Ordered, that the confideration of Mr. De Bonne's motion be postponed until the 20th instant.

On motion of Mr. P. L. Panet, seconded by Mr. Coffin,

Ordered, that the order of the day, to take into confideration the report of the Committee upon the Bill, to establish the form of Registers of Baptisms, Marriages and Burials, and which provides for the want or loss of said Registers, be discharged.

Then the ingressed Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled " An " Act to alter and amend the Criminal Law in certain cases, and to pro-

" vide more effectual remedies against the commission of crimes and of-

" fences"-was read for the first time.

On motion of Mr. Lees, feconded by Mr. P. L. Panet,

Ordered, that one hundred copies of the Bill be printed in French and English, under the direction of Mr. Speaker, with all convenient speed, and that two copies in each language be sent by the Clerk of this House to each member in town, as soon as can be conveniently done.

Then on motion of Mr. Lees, seconded by Mr. Le Gras Pierreville,

The House adjourned till to morrow at three o'clock in the afternoon.
