

the body of any person deceased within or out of the same, in any place or Church yard situated within the walls of such City or Town, shall incur a penalty of—pounds.

4. That the fines incurred as above shall be sued for, levied and applied in the same manner as the fines imposed by the said Bill.

5. That the Preamble of the said Bill be altered so as to correspond with the additional clauses resulting from the above resolutions.

A Message from the Legislative Council by the Honorable Mr. De Longueuil,

Mr. Speaker,

The Legislative Council have passed a Bill, intituled “ An Act to alter and amend the criminal Law in certain cases, and to provide more effectual remedies against the commission of crimes and offences,”—to which the Legislative Council desire the concurrence of this House.

And then he withdrew.

The House resumed the consideration of Mr. De Bonne’s motion.

*Ordered*, that the order of the day, to take into consideration the report of the Committee upon the Bill, to establish the form of Registers of Baptisms, Marriages and Burials, and which provides for the want or loss of said Registers, be discharged.

Then the ingrossed Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled “ An Act to alter and amend the Criminal Law in certain cases, and to provide more effectual remedies against the commission of crimes and offences”—was read for the first time.

On motion of Mr. Lees, seconded by Mr. P. L. Panet,

*Ordered*, that one hundred copies of the Bill be printed in French and English, under the direction of Mr. Speaker, with all convenient speed, and that two copies in each language be sent by the Clerk of this House to each member in town, as soon as can be conveniently done.

Then on motion of Mr. Lees, seconded by Mr. Le Gras Pierreville,

The House adjourned till to-morrow at three o’clock in the afternoon.
