Milne In Florida.
Dayton, Fla., Marce 24, 1916.

Dear Gazette:

Since writing you last we have been very busy on the move and have taken in everything of interest on the south east coast of Florida, many of which, while of intense interest to us on the spot, would not interest your readers, so will only mention very few here.

Have witnessed several National games played at Miami and Palm Beach. Saw the league lawn tennis game played between Herb Throckmorton of Cornell University fame, and J. D. Wright of Chicago, both noted champions. It took several days to play the set and finally, after making new world records, Throckmorton won out by a narrow margin amidst the thunderous applause of an excited multitude from the grand stands and bleachers, and it certainly was the most interesting and hotly contested game I ever saw. Often the ball passed from side to side without touching ground for from fifteen to twenty times.

Next came the boat race for swift gasoline craft on the Bay of Biscayne. On the last day of the Regatta Commodore Kitcher's "Betty II" split the water at the rate of 24 miles an hour, setting a new record and won the laurels. Some of these racers send water and spray 10 to 15 feet high clearing the surface of the sun-shimmering

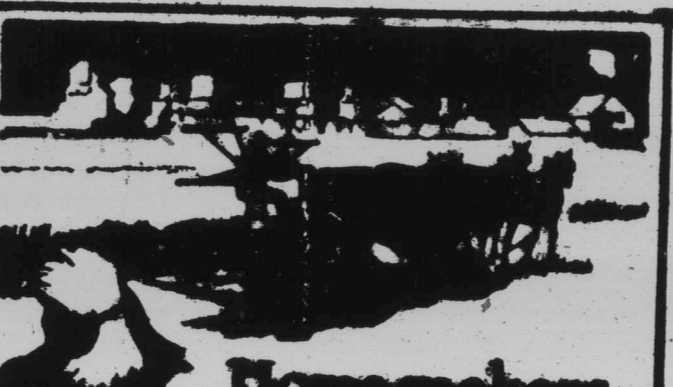
