Prohibition of indiscriminate slash burning and regulation of forest travel, two important steps which have been taken towards the prevention of forest fires in this province, are believed to be largely responsible for the lack of serious forest fires in New Brunswick.

Brunswick this year in spite of the long periods of continued dry weather.

Despite the fact that forest fires have so far not been serious this season the Department of Lands and Mines through its forest service is constantly prepared to cope with any situation which may rise insofar as human activities can accomplish anything. Just what is being accomplished by the lookout system that has been established in the way of locating fires is by an incident contained in the reports regarding fires which reached the Department in the last month.

The lookouts at the towers at St. Quentin and Mount Carleton recently registered a heavy black smoke to the northwest of their locations. Both lookouts immediately reported, the angles were plotted and the location read from the map gave two miles north of the Pollard Brook, a branch of the Matapedia, on the inter-provincial boundary between New Brunswick and Quebec. Crews were dispatched to investigate and returned with the information that a party of fishermen had built a large smudge on the beach to keep mosquitoes away. The smudge had made the smoke which had been spotted by the lookouts, who believed it to be a fire breaking out. The same party moved down stream some distance and made another smudge which the lookouts also spotted later that afternoon. And one lookout was thirty-six miles away and the other was fifty-six miles distant.

The gentlemen responsible for the smudge fires was a lessee of fishing waters and when the matter was brought to his attention he forwarded his check for the amount involved.
