Mrs. Anna Louisa Henly-Lewis yeserday made application in the suprem court before Judge Stuart to have her costs secured in the appeal action against her, which comes up before the court of appeal en banc in June. The application was, however, dismissed by his lordship.

Since the trial of the action Miss Callard became Mrs. Henly-Lewis, and now lives in Calgary with her hus-band. Her counsel at the trial was P J. Nolan, and, incidentally, at this big case, which was his last, he made a strenuous appeal for his client, which proved most telling with the jury.
