TOPICS WHO FIGURED AMONG THE ALSO RANS
Vegreville and Whitford Returns Show Conservative Candidates Far at the Foot of the Polls
Vegreville, April 28.—In this constituency the Conservatives hoped that by bringing an independent Lutheran candidate into the field they would be able to deflect a sufficient number of votes from the Liberal candidates to make sure the election of their candidate, Morrison. The result, however, as given below, shows that when the show-down came the Conservative figures at the bottom of the poll, while Joseph McCallum, the Liberal, has an easy majority over the independent.
In Whitford reports for a long time were to the effect that one or the other of the independent candidates had been elected, but when the full returns appeared it is shown that Alex. Shandro, the Liberal nominee, is the one appointed and that by a comfortable majority. Mr. Shandro, who is a native of the north country, is the first Russian to be elected to a seat in a British house of legislation since the Twelfth Parliament, figured at the foot of the poll.

SECURING OF COSTS IS REFUSED MISS CALLARD
Heroine of First Breach of Promise Case of Alberta Wanted Favor for Appeal Case Which Will Be Heard in June
Mrs. Anna Louisa Henly-Lewis yesterday made application in the supreme court before Judge Stuart to have her costs secured in the appeal action against her, which came up before the court of appeal on June 10. The application was, however, dismissed by his lordship.
Mrs. Henly-Lewis, who was formerly Miss Callard, was the heroine of the first breach of promise action of the province of Alberta and from Martin James Armstrong, a wealthy rancher of Nanton, she was awarded by the district court a sum of \$20,000, after having asked for \$25,000, to soothe her injured feelings. Immediately after the decision Mr. Armstrong, through his counsel, A. A. McGillivray, entered an appeal which will be heard in the court of appeal on June 10.
Since the trial of the action Miss Callard became Mrs. Henly-Lewis, and now lives in Calgary with her husband. Her control at the trial was P. J. Nolan, and incidentally, at this big case, which was his last, he made a strenuous appeal for his client, which proved most telling with the jury.
