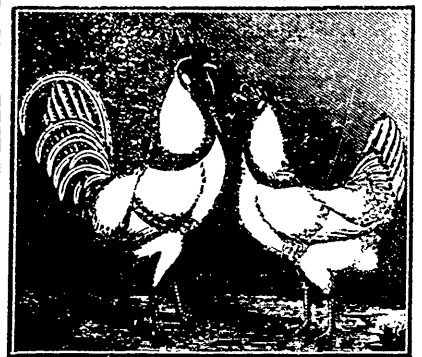
NONE OF BREEDING BIRDS SCORE BELOW 92
