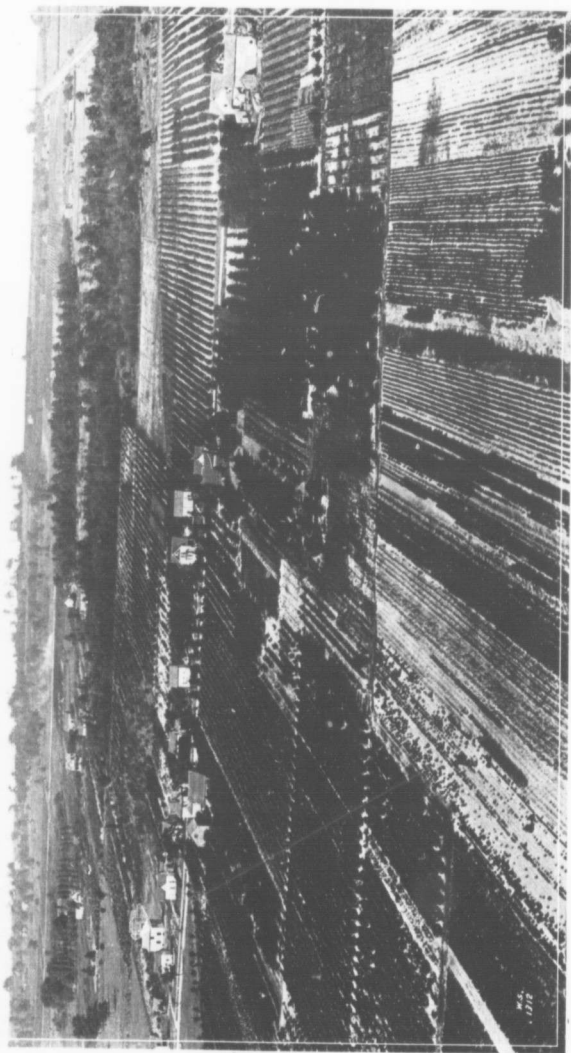




FRUIT FARMS IN THE GRIMSBY DISTRICT, NIAGARA PENINSULA.
