Herald has been interviewing Mr. R. G. Leckie, president of the Cumberland Railway & Coal Co., who has just returned from a visit to the coal and iron mines of Great Britain. Concerning the future of the Works Mr. Leckie thought a re-organization probable, into which Canadian capital will be put, and parties in the country being largely interested the business is likely to be more successful. dry pig. Another important point is the cheapening of fuel, the coke being obtained at a cheaper rate than before. This is made to a great extent from Spring Hill slack, which produces a large and firm coke, with a very small per centage of ash. Iron at the present moment is as low or perhaps lower than has ever been known in the history of the trade. And if these works can hold their own under existing conditions, they are likely to yield a good return to the proprietors upon the improvement of business to which all are looking confidently forward."
