ARTICLE 3

The subjects of each of the contracting parties in the territories of the other shall be at full liberty to acquire and possess every description of property movable and immovable, which the laws of the other contracting party permit or shall permit, the subjects or citizens of any other foreign country to acquire and possess. They may dispose of the same by sale, exchange, gift, marriage testament, or in any other manner, or acquire the same by inheritance under the same conditions which are or shall be established with regard to subjects of the other contracting party. They shall not be subjected in any of the case mentioned to any taxes, imposts or charges of whatever denomination other higher than those which are or shall be applicable to subjects of the other contracting party.

The subjects of each of the contracting parties shall also be permitted, of compliance with the laws of the other contracting party, freely to export proceeds of the sale of their property and their goods in general without being subjected as foreigners to other or higher duties than those to which subjects of such party would be liable under similar circumstances.

ARTICLE 4

The subjects of each of the contracting parties in the territories of the other shall be exempted from all compulsory military service whatsover, whether in the army, navy, national guard or militia. They shall similarly be exempted from all judicial administrative of from all judicial, administrative and municipal functions whatever, other than those imposed by the laws relating to juries, as well as from all contributions whether possessions or in his desired to juries. whether pecuniary or in kind, imposed as an equivalent for personal service and finally from any military and finally from any military exaction or requisition.
