

The Commission was further informed that the Government of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam had placed this matter before the Co-Chairmen of the Geneva Conference and had requested them to review the decision of the Commission and that the Commission should, therefore, defer the implementation of its decision pending the recommendation of the Co-Chairmen of the Geneva Conference. A copy of the letter dated 14th June, 1958, from His Excellency the Prime Minister of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam addressed to the Co-Chairmen raising the issue was also forwarded to the Commission. The Commission drew the attention of the P.A.V.N. High Command to the fact that on 7th June 1958, the Commission communicated its decision to the Co-Chairmen and on 14th June 1958, the Government of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam addressed a communication to the Co-Chairmen on this decision of the Commission. The Commission informed the P.A.V.N. High Command that it received no communication from the Co-Chairmen on the point raised by the Government of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam nor was it informed by the Government of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam of any reply received by them to their letter to the Co-Chairmen. The Commission also informed the P.A.V.N. High Command that in arriving at the decision the Commission carefully considered the provisions of the Geneva Agreement, the Protocol signed between the Parties and the Final Declaration, and that the Commission had in the past reviewed its decisions under the Geneva Agreement, and would continue to do so whenever it considered necessary, in the performance of its tasks of supervision and control of the execution of the provisions of the Agreement by the Parties.
