Issues to be Reviewed and Reported on by the Committee.

In preparing its report, the Committee will review:

- Existing Canadian international aviation policy, the historical basis on which it was developed, and the manner in which it is applied.
- 2) Bilateral agreements entered into between Canada and other nations for the exchange of international air services and the status of rights held by each carrier under the individual agreements.
- 3) The criteria used in determining the application of the multiple carrier designation policy.
- 4) Canada's air charter policy, whether it is consistent with international air policy, and whether it requires an overhaul.
- 5) The role air services play in Canada's tourism strategy.
- 6) The role air services play in Canada's trade strategy.
- The emerging global competitive situation, considering such factors as the formation of airline alliances, the EC in 1992, and the development of Computer Reservation System networks, the impact of the Free Trade Agreement with the U.S.A. and other international trade agreements.
