to experiment with this. I believe that we won't be able to change the tax system overnight, nor will we be able to balance the federal deficit and the budget overnight, but if we can have a healthy attitude of reform in the sense that we're looking at the system, is it fair. Most people I talk to don't believe that the tax system is fair. Is it complicated? Of course it is. In fact it's too complicated. Does the tax system provide the right kind of incentives for investment and economic activity in growth rather than just avoiding the taxman and I don't think that it does either. So we have a complicated, unfair and in some cases irrational system that we believe that could be better and could be fairer and contribute, an awful more here in this country towards health and education and roads and in terms of deficits. I believe that they will look at it.
