

Wang Zhongyu

State Councillor

Wang Zhongyu was born in February 1933 at Changchun in the province of Jilin. He graduated from the training centre of the Party School of the Communist Party of China's Central Committee. His college education was in engineering.

Through the 1960s and 1970s, Mr. Wang held several positions in the Jilin Paper Mill, rising to the position of chief engineer of the paper mill's Revolutionary Committee in 1980. After serving in several senior party positions in the province of Jilin through the 1980s, he became Governor.

From 1992 to 1993, Mr. Wang served at the senior levels of the party's Leading Group of the Production Office and the party's Leading Group of the Economic and Trade Office under the State Council. From 1993 to 1998, he was director and secretary of the party's Leading Group of the State Economic and Trade Commission.

Mr. Wang has worked concurrently as State Councillor and Secretary-General of the State Council since March 1998.
