PRAYERS

Mr. Ethier, from the Standing Committee on National Resources and Public Works, presented the Third Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Friday, October 25, 1974, your Committee has considered the Agreement on an International Energy Program and reports the same.
