1. On what date was it first suggested that a causeway be constructed from the mainland to Lennox Island

Mr. Yves Forest (Parliamentary Secretary to President of the Privy Council): I am informed by the Department of Public Works and the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development as follows: 1. August 1964.

2. June 1965, November 1965 and August 1969.

3. It is not customary to give estimated costs before contracts are awarded.

ernment of the Province of Prince Edward Island are still discussing the possibility of constructing a causeway between the Prince Edward Island mainland and Lennox Island.
