Moved by Dr. H. H. McIntosh, Vancouver, seconded by Dr. R. B. Boucher, Vancouver, and carried, Whereas certain criticism has been offered by the McGill Graduates regarding recent staff appointments; And Whereas we consider the addition of prominent and scientific men to the staff will add lustre and efficiency to McGill; Be It Therefore Resolved that we endorse the action of the Board of Gov ernors in securing the services of the most scientific and progressive men available, regardless of nationality but giving preference always to men of British citizenship. Moved by Dr. I. Glen Campbell, Vancouver, seconded by Dr. B. D. Gillies, Vancouver, and carried, Whereas we believe the interests of McGill could be greatly furthered and our discussions of McGill affairs made much more intelligent by closer contact with the teaching staff; Be It Therefore Resolved that we respectfully suggest to the proper authorities that they arrange as a definite programme for the frequent periodical visits of some members of the staff to all the

large centres of Canada to meet and discuss with the local associations affairs of interest and importance to McGill.
