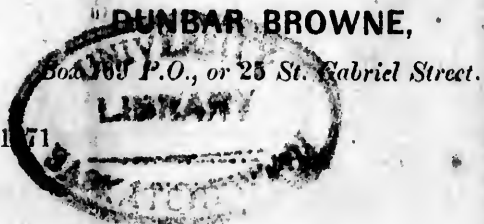
Each number will contain all the Orange News, the Orange Constitution, and a tale founded on the connection of the Association.
