

LIVERPOOL BREAK CHIEF INFLUENCE

Grain Prices at Chicago Responsive to Firmness at Other Centres.

CHICAGO, April 28.—Weakness at Liverpool today lowered wheat values...

Heaviness, which has become pronounced today, influential selling, on predictions of large increases in receipts...

Receipts of farm produce were 8 loads of hay, about 30 loads in buggies and light wagons...

Butter—Receipts were large and prices about steady at 30c to 35c, the bulk going at 32c to 33c.

Eggs—Receipts were very large, and sold at 26c to 28c per dozen.

Poultry—There was scarcely enough poultry to make a market, and prices were firm at quotations given in table.

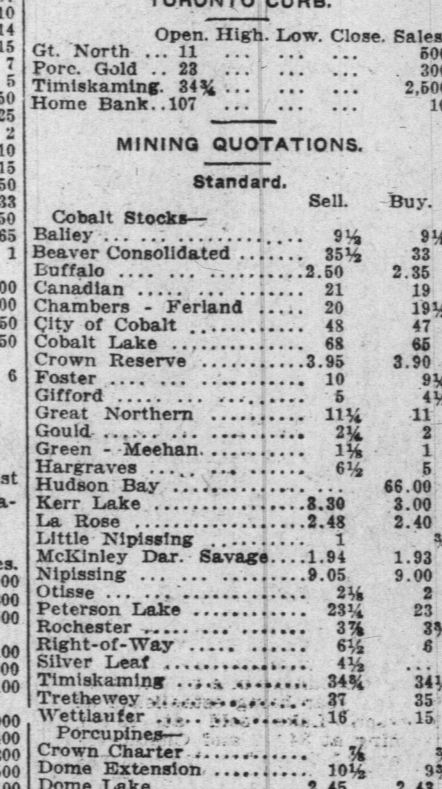
