

Pears.—Same standard of grade as for Apples.

Size Designation.—The number of pears in each box to be marked on the end. Recognised count for standard Pear Boxes are as follows:—80, 90, 100, 110, 120, 135, 150, 165, 180, 195, 210.

Vegetable Grades.

Potatoes (Selected), White Varieties.—Maximum size one pound, minimum five ounces in weight. Free from scab, knobs, sunscald. Sound, smooth skinned, well-matured stock. All sacks to be tagged with specially printed tags.

Potatoes (Red and White).—Maximum size two pounds, minimum four ounces in weight. Free from bad knobs, sunscald; free from scab. Matured, sound stock.

Potatoes (Red Early), Up to August 1st.—Minimum size, three ounces. Reasonably well matured, free from sunscald.

Cabbage.—Well trimmed, clean, hard heads. Danish Bald Head and Copenhagen Market varieties to be packed as such. Other varieties as Cabbage.

Onions (Crates).—Must be graded, and sound, clean, dry, good keeping stock, of uniform medium size, minimum size 2 inches diameter.

Onions (Sacks).—Sound, clean, dry stock. All very small, or coarse, large onions to be kept out.

Parsnips, Carrots, Turnips and Beets.—Must be free from splits, prongs, and no coarse, overgrown stock allowed.

Tomatoes (Ripe) No. 1.—Smooth, clean skin, free from disease or cracks. Uniform medium size. Firm shipping stock, carefully packed. Wrapped, maximum size 3x2.

Tomatoes (Ripe) No. 2.—Free from disease. May vary in size. Firm stock. Carefully packed, unwrapped. Maximum size 60s, minimum 108s.
