The "Act to Restrain the Use of Tobacco by Young Persons," passed by parliament in July, 1908, is a very important law, and its enactment under government leadership, with the support of both sides of the house, the chief criticism to which it was exposed being that it does not go far enough, is significant. It means that parliament is increasingly favorable to Moral Reform legislation if persuaded that it is necessary, reasonable and practicable, and it means that the world of hard-headed business and professional men in and out of parliament are convinced by observation and scientific testimony that the use of tobacco by growing youths is so seriously harmful as to imperatively call for legislative interference with liberty in order to save the lives and preserve the health of Canadian boys and girls,—in other words, that the national well-being demanded such action.

The law is not perfect. The age limit might well have been raised to eighteen, as was done unanimously by the commons, though it was subsequently reduced to sixteen by the senate. This may be remedied at some future session, along with other defects that may emerge with experience.
