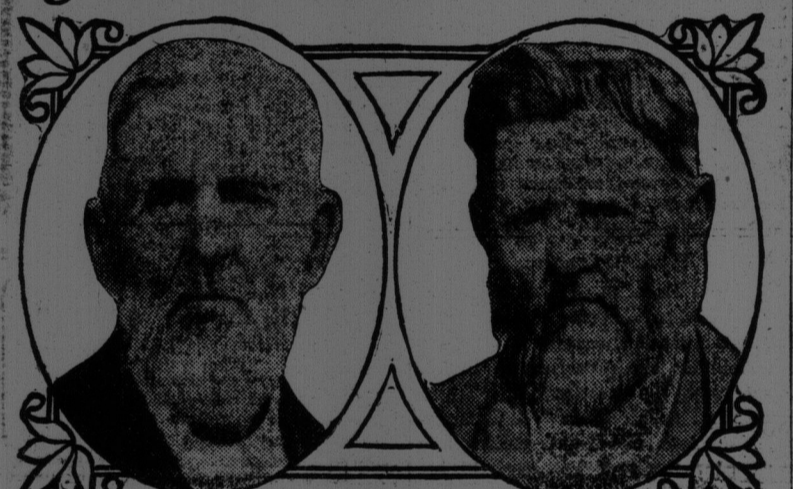

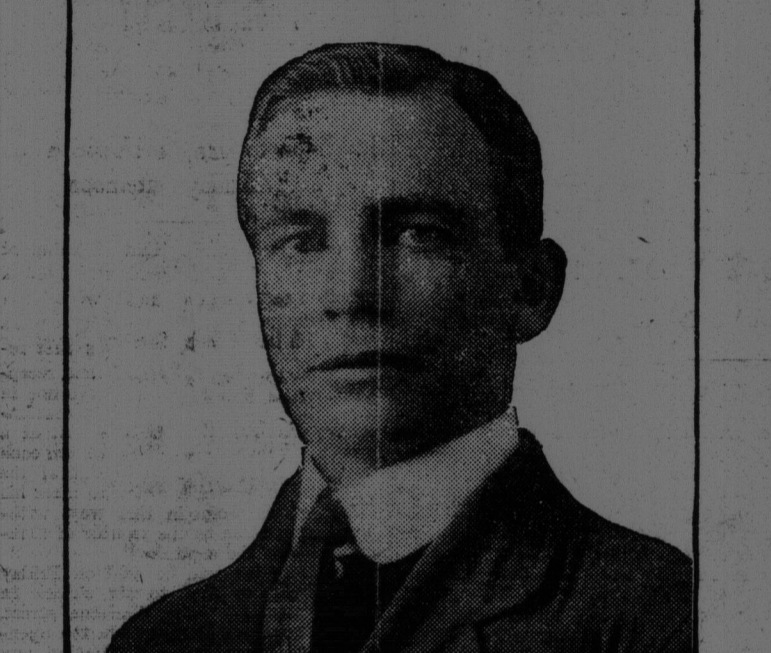

## Daily Hints For the Cook

### Sunshine Cake

Seven fresh eggs, scant teaspoonful of salt, cupful of flour, 1 cupful sugar, 2 teaspoons lemon juice, any flavoring preferred.

Separate eggs, add salt to whites. Beat them to a foam, add lemon juice gradually, beating whites until they are stiff. Sift sugar over, add to whites and fold in until dissolved. Then beat yolks stiff. Add yolks to whites and fold them through. Sift flour 5 times, measure, add it to eggs and fold in lightly. Bake in ungreased mold. Makes a large cake and is delicious.

### Meal Fritters

Cut cold tender cooked meat in fingers or slices and dip into batter or chop and stir into the batter seasoned with salt, pepper and herbs or chopped onion as desired.

Plain Fritter Batter—This batter is used for all fritters as fruit, meat, clams, etc. One cup flour, 1-2 teaspoon baking powder, 1-4 teaspoonful salt, 2 eggs, 1 cup of milk. Sift dry ingredients together, add beaten eggs and milk and beat until smooth.

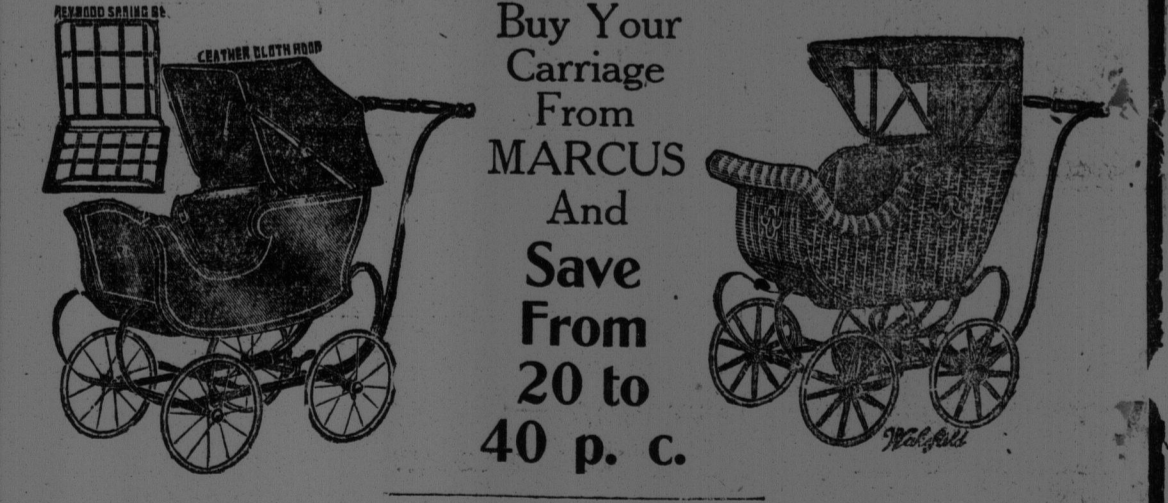
