

### DRUNKEN AUTO DRIVERS A MENACE

New Jersey Commissioner Revoked 400 Licenses Last Year Because of Intoxication.

Harrisburg, Pa., March 28.—Intoxicated drivers of motor vehicles were a greater menace than at present, A. W. Bill, Commissioner Motor Vehicles of New Jersey told a conference of Highway Commissioners and Engineers from twenty-one States, Commissioner Bill said that last year in New Jersey he revoked more than 400 drivers' licenses for intoxication.

The motor laws of Pennsylvania and New York were deficient, Commissioner Bill said, and this was of particular interest to New Jersey because during the summer months the roads of New Jersey seashore points were used by more foreign cars than those of New Jersey.

of drivers. In New Jersey we require that men and women who drive cars must be fitted to drive them, and capable of driving them, and our tests are not only written and oral, but take into consideration the physical and moral conditions of the applicants. American States are remiss in automobile regulation. In thirty-five of the forty-eight States the laws are woefully inadequate.

A resolution introduced by Colonel Frederick Stuart Greene, Highway Commissioner of New York State, calling for a tax on gasoline to help pay for road maintenance was passed by the conference.

Word was received last night that an attempt to float the British schooner F. C. Lockhart, hailing from here and which stranded early this week on Libby Island, near Machiasport, was made yesterday by the United States coast guard cutter Ossipee. A portion of the cargo of fertilizer in the vessel was removed during the attempt. The schooner was bound for an eastern port.

### Frozen North May Be Wheat Country

(Vancouver Sun.)

The establishment of a chain of wireless stations extending from Dawson City to Fort Smith, and including Fort Resolution, Simpson, Norman and McPherson, is primarily, for the purpose of keeping federal officials in touch with one another, but it certainly will come to mean much more than that. It will establish between the Arctic and the more southerly regions of the Dominion a practical and swift means of communication. It will bring the northland into daily touch with the world, instead of the present delayed and often long-drawn-out connection by mail alone.

### QUEEN ALEXANDRA STILL REIGNS IN HEARTS OF PEOPLE

Mother of King George Has Held Affections of Britons for Sixty Years by Gentle Ways and Kind Acts.

London, (By Mail).—Sixty years ago this month Princess Alexandra of Denmark—Tennyson's "Sea King's daughter" from over the sea—landed in England to become the bride of Edward Prince of Wales. The memory of the wonderful welcome she received is as vivid today as ever, the Queen Mother declared in a message broadcast to the British people in which she sets on record her gratitude for "the loyal and devoted sympathy shown to me both in my joy and sorrows."

The hold on the affections of the British people which she won as a fair young princess, little more than eighteen years old, Queen Alexandra never has lost in sixty years. Always regal in her manner, she still has reigned in the hearts of the public more as a woman than a queen, and the gentleness of her nature has been shown in countless little ways. Once in a Paddington hospital she asked a tiny sufferer where she lived. "In Edgeware Road, opposite Garrold's (a big department store)," was the child's reply. "And where do you live?" she asked the Queen in turn. "In the Buckingham Palace road, opposite Garrold's (another department store)," said Queen Alexandra.

When King Edward died, in 1910, the Queen-Mother sought retirement at Sandringham and Marlborough House. Though she still is frequently to be seen driving almost unattended through the streets of London, she has lived in later years a somewhat secluded life, devoting herself largely to the royal family. Rarely a day passes

when both are in London that the King does not visit his mother at Marlborough House, where another constant visitor is the Prince of Wales.

### BACHELOR ENDS LIFE IN LAKE

W. L. Swett, Farmer, Sixth of His Family to Commit Suicide

Killed His Favorite Horse—Used Axe to Slay Animal and Revolver Upon Himself in Unsuccessful Effort to Die.

Trenton, N. J., March 28.—The body of a wealthy bachelor farmer and recluse, residing about two miles below Hightstown, was discovered in a small lake on his property by a friend, Dr. George A. Silver of Hightstown. Swett is believed to have been a suicide.

Swett had been acting strangely and had been melancholy since the death several weeks ago of his aunt, Miss Helen Stults, who had kept house for him for a number of years. Since he died he had been living alone in the house, which, although located hardly more than a mile from Hightstown, is somewhat isolated.

A pet horse of the farmer's was found slain near its stable. An axe had been used.

Dr. Silver is of the opinion that Swett singled the horse out from among his others because he had been devoted to the animal and did not want it to be subject to harsh treatment after he died.

Swett wrote a letter to Dr. Silver last Wednesday. In this letter he asked the physician to take care of his property in the event anything happened to him.

According to the authorities, Swett had attempted to slay himself with a revolver which was found near the body. A bullet wound was discovered in his hip, but it was slight. Failing to kill himself with the weapon, Swett is believed to have thrown himself face downward into the lake. He was found in that position.

Coroner Bray was notified and the body was turned over to Rogers & Son, undertakers, of Hightstown. The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon from the Swett home, with interment in East Windsor cemetery.

### ONLY 20 YEARS OLD, WILL MARRY AGAIN

Jamaica Youth, Paying for Support of Son by First Marriage, to Wed Girl of Seventeen.

New York, March 28.—Frank Hartman, 20 years old, Jamaica, holds the record for marriages of persons of his age, according to the experts in the Queens Marriage License Bureau, where he applied for a license to marry Miss Catharine Pfeifferman, 17 years old, also of Jamaica. When he applied to Deputy City Clerk William Zimmerman for his license, he presented papers showing that his marriage to Charlotte Oswald, which he contracted about two years ago, had been annulled by Justice Selah B. Strong in the Supreme Court. These papers also showed that there was a son by the first marriage and that Hartman is paying \$5 a week for the support of this child.

Both Hartman and his prospective bride were so young that their parents had to accompany them to the Marriage License Bureau and give their consent before the license was issued. Hartman said that his marriage to Miss Pfeifferman would occur on Easter Sunday.

Frederick Reardon, who was charged with having liquor in his beer shop in Water street, was found guilty by the Magistrate yesterday afternoon and fined \$200. This case was heard earlier

in the week and was postponed until yesterday afternoon for judgment. E. J. Henchberry appeared for the accused and W. M. Ryan for the prosecution. The fine was paid.
