SAFETY FIRST.

Mention is made in another column of the organization here on Tuesday evening next of a St. John Branch of the Maritime Safety League, the intensely useful and practical work of which is attracting more and more attention daily.

The Safety League is not the sort of institution that is satisfied with speeches and resolutions. It seeks to organize an army of citizens, men, women and children, who will take the principles of safety to heart, and be thoughtful and alert in preventing accidents of every character.

ANNEXATION—NEW VERSION.

A solemnly worded special cable from London, written by a correspondent serving the Toronto Globe and the Chicago Tribune, informs all and sundry that politicians in London have received "a rude shock" because of certain developments in Canada.

The Canadian Premier, of course, never made any such statement, or said anything which could reasonably be so interpreted. If he, or any other public man in Canada, had said what was evidently called to London, the shock would have been even greater in this country than across the water.

The correspondent betrays considerable anxiety over the situation which he apparently believes has been created, saying that politicians in the Old Country, "while knowing the discontent in Canada and other parts of the Empire, hoped it would blow over without the necessity of formal recognition or action."

ACROSS THE LINE.

The recent summary of business conditions in the United States, issued by the National City Bank of New York, the largest bank in that country, tends to show how shortsighted and thoughtless is the statement, too often heard, that the Canadian people are suffering from a business depression which their neighbors have escaped.

The statement of the National City Bank, which should tend to restore a sense of proportion among people on our side of the line, shows that the revived state of industrial activity which marked the first quarter of the year passed its high point by the middle of March and that a downward movement followed.




