with regard to the enclosed resolution I beg to report that the Indians is in need of some Lumber and in great need of shingles as many of the buildings needs re-shingling, it will cost about \$2.75 per 1000 ft for sawing lumber and \$1.00 per 1000 for cutting shingles, the mill owner to take his pay in Lumber at full market value, there was some saw logs cut last winter most of them were left in the bush for the want of snow. I will send the exact terms as soon as I can find a man to do the work. the prices cited above will be about right. most of the wood that the Indians proposes to cut is down timber and some of them has to do something to get through the winter but they want cut march wood most of the young men works out in the shantys
