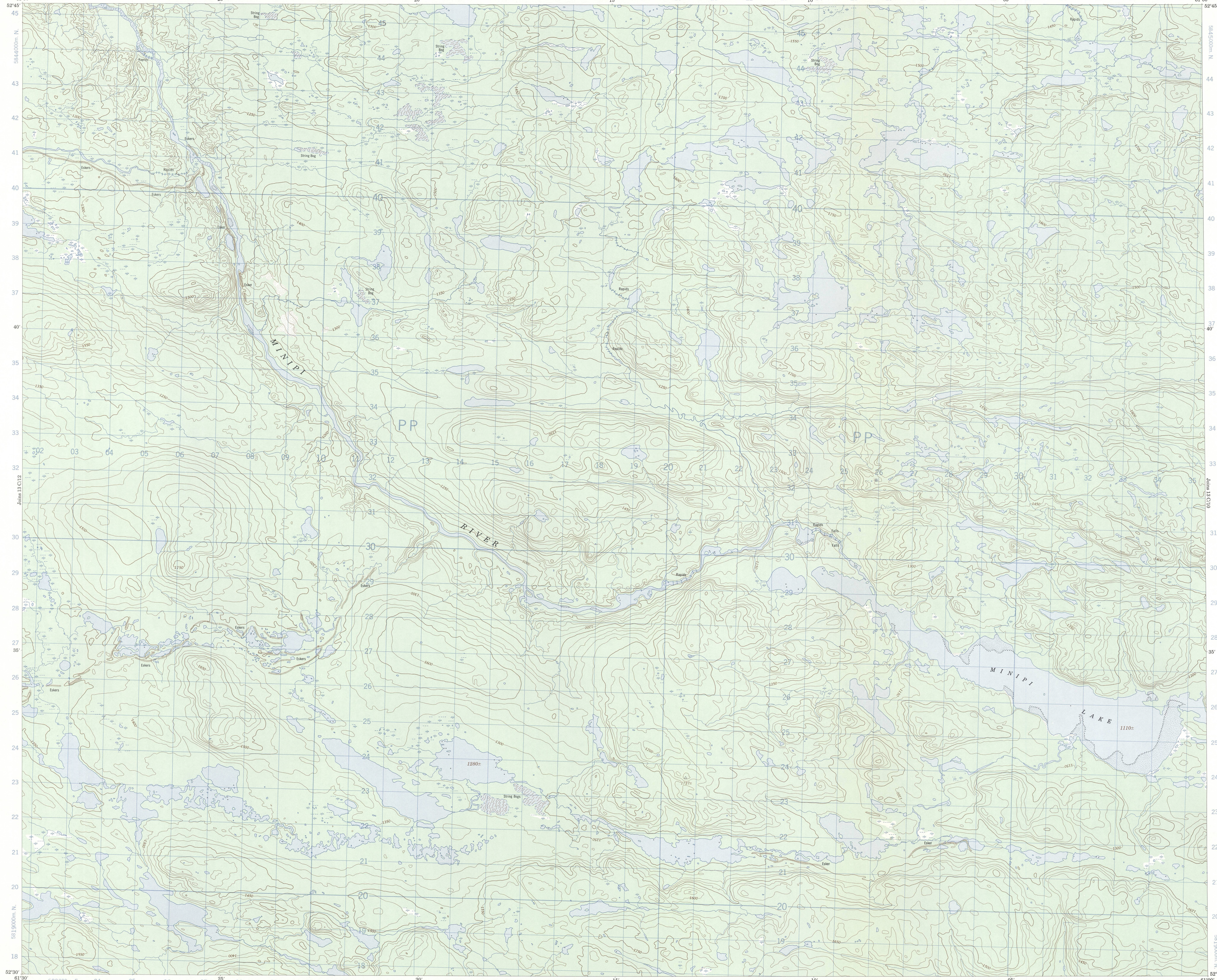
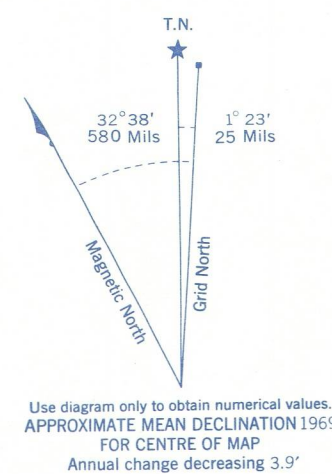

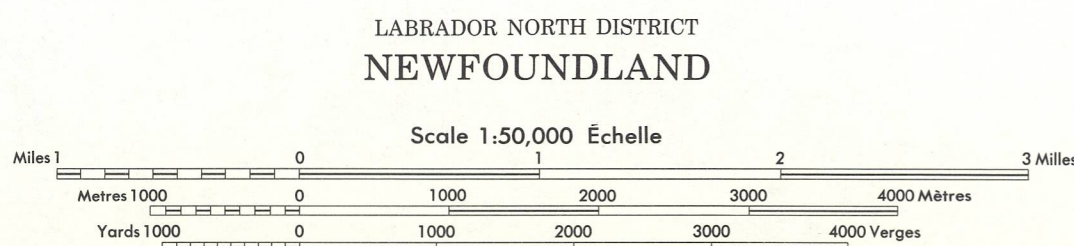

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCES IS A SIMPLE ONLY AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THE MAP	
REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (see above)
EASTING: Road number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimate tenth of a square from this line eastward to point	15
NORTHING: Road number on grid line immediately below point	98
Estimate tenth of a square from this line northward to point	4
EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	97984
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
