DISARMAMENT NOW

Mr. Trueblood Says Peace Congress Not Asking for That Immediately

HAS A SCHEME

LCNDON, July 30.—"Many signs of the increasing importance of the peace movement have developed during the progress of the present universal peace congress," said Benjamin F. Trueblood of Boston, president of the American Peace Society and head of the American delegation now here, in an interview tonight. "First, we have seen the number of delegates grow until every civilized nation of the globe now is represented at the congress—and by men of standing in their own countries. The meetings of the congress have been exceedingly well attended and the greatest interest has been displayed in the discussions, the most important of which was that of today, on the subpest of the arrest of armaments.

"Make it clear," Mr. Trueblood continued, "that we are not urging immediate disarmament, but a scheme by which the increasing expenditure for armaments can be stopped.
