WELLS, Hon. RUPERT MEARSE. [*South Bruce.*] 2nd Mem.

Of Eng. descent. S. of James Pendleton Wells, Esq., Sheriff of the United Counties of Prescott and Russell. B. in Co. of Prescott, 1835. Ed. at Toronto University, where he was Jameson medallist and silver medallist in ethics, and graduated B.A., 1854. Unmarried. Called to the Bar, U.C., Trinity Term, 1857. Was associated in business with Hon. Ed. Blake, from 1860 to 1870, but is now a partner of Mr. Angus Morrison, Q.C. Held the County Attorneyship of York from 1871 to 1872, when he resigned in order to become a candidate for South Bruce.
