

Over fifteen and not exceeding thirty, the sum of..... Fifteen Shillings.
 Upwards of thirty, the sum of..... One Pound.
 On making search, inspecting each copy of By-law, and examining
 entries connected therewith..... Five Shillings.

5 And the fees received therefor shall form part of the general revenue of this
 Province, and shall be so received by the Receiver General and accounted for by
 him.

IX. In all such cases as require the submission of any By-law or By-laws
 to the Governor General of this Province for his sanction, such sanction must first
 10 be obtained to bring the same within the meaning of the words "final passing
 thereof" in the second section of this Act.

X. This Act shall not extend to the By-laws, or Debentures thereunder, of
 any Railway Company or any Ecclesiastical Corporation heretofore incorporated or
 hereafter to be incorporated, or the Debentures issued by any Religious Denomina-
 15 tion in its Corporate capacity, either in Upper or Lower Canada.
