And be it enacted, That this Act shall be known Interpretation 10 and cited as "The Montreal Registry Act," and the Commissioners aforesaid shall be known as "The Commissioners under the Montreal Registry Act;" the Interpretation Act shall apply to this Act; and the word "Instrument" in this Act shall include as well the deed or instruliment which is affected by the registration, as the memorial thereof when the registration is by memorial.
