

## An Act to amend the Act 23 Victoria, Chapter 123.

**W**HEREAS the Corporation of Pilots for and above the Harbour of Quebec, have by their petition prayed that the Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Canada, 23 Victoria, Chapter 123, may be so amended as to provide that any pilot who shall have caused any damage or loss while acting in the execution of his duties shall alone be responsible therefor, and whereas the prayer of the petition is just; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The Corporation constituted in virtue of the Act passed by the Parliament of the late Province of Canada, in the twenty-third year of Her Majesty's reign, and intitled: "An Act to incorporate the pilots for and below the Harbour of Quebec," shall not hereafter be held responsible for the acts of any pilot while acting as such nor for any damages caused by any act, fault, or negligence on the part of such pilot, but the amount which may be due by the said Corporation to such pilot on account of his share of the revenue thereof, shall form part of the property against which the creditors of such pilot may enforce their legal remedy, either on account of damages caused by him, or of any other matter; provided always that nothing contained in this Act shall extend to or affect suits now pending.
