CAP. CII.

An Act to revive and continue, until the First Day of January One thousand eight hundred and One, the Bounties granted by an Act, made in the Twentyfixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for encouraging the Fisheries carried on at Newfoundland, and Parts adjacent, from Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe.

HEREAS so much of an Act, made in the Twenty-sixth Year Preamble. of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act to 26 Geo. 111, amend and render more effectual the several Laws now in Force Cap. 26. for encouraging the Fisheries carried on at Newfoundland, and Parts adjacent, from Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe, and for granting Eounties for a limited Time, on certain Terms and Conditions, as relates to the Bounties thereby granted, which was to continue in Force for the Term of Ten Years, from the First Day of January One thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven, and which was revived, and further continued for Two Years, by an Act made in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, has been found useful and beneficial: And whereas it is expedient, That so much of the said Act 9 M
