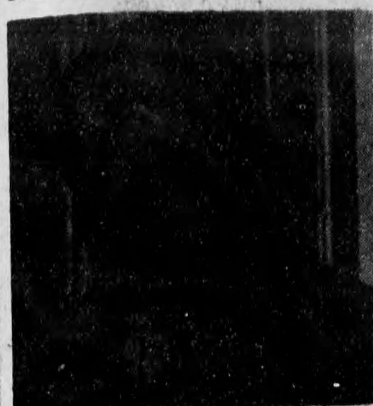


# Viewpoint

There weren't enough shots of the campus. There should have been more color pictures, and it wasn't thick enough. Why was the cover in St. Thomas colors?



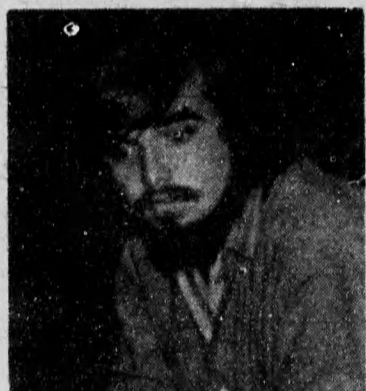
Donna Kingland Arts 4
