

Amherstburg 20th June 1820

Sir,

I have the honor to enclose to you a Copy taken from the Original in Col. Hawkins's hand Writing of the Prophet's Speech against me delivered in the Col.'s Quarters in presence of Capt. Reed and Mr. Jackson. I was informed of their Meeting by the Col. and attended it his Quarters. On the subject they leave to refer you to my letter of the 24th ultimo wherein I stated the Basis on which I had been informed he intended to meet the Superintendent and his astonishment at my appointment without his knowledge.

As far as relates to the late Superintendent, the intimacy and brotherly friendship which has subsisted between him and me for upwards of 30 years, as is well known
